Please Bring Your Family Fare & Econofoods Receipts to Church

Donating your Family Fare / Econofoods receipts to Sparta UMC supports the missions of the church. Bring your receipts to church, leaving the entire grocery receipt in the blue basket distributed at the conclusion of the worship service, or in the white mail box in Wesley Hall, or in the church office. To date, \$97,666 has been received in Direct Your Dollars—that's another \$4,000 since February 21, and with Easter Sunday dinner quickly approaching, please remember Sparta UMC's need for your grocery receipts!

The Direct Your Dollars amount is noted at the bottom of your cash register receipt. When Sparta UMC has collected \$150,000 in Direct Your Dollar receipts, Missions will receive \$1,000. (FYI: some purchases do not apply, like gasoline and gift cards from Family Fare)

Receipts that qualify can come from any of the 160 Spartan-Nash-owned retail stores or fuel centers in nine states.
